Hollywood Booster Crime Prevention Committee Report

In order to keep Hollywood safe and discourage crime the following are recommendations to all of us.

NO TRESPASSING AGREEMENT

This agreement allows police to enter on to your property and remove trespassers 24 hours a day. (see attachment) Fill out and fax to 503-823-0342.

CAR PROWL

Many of car prowls go unreported. –Report – Report. The more reporting of any crime will cause the police to assign more officers to a problematic area. More Reporting – More Patrols.

HOMELESS ON SIDEWALKS

There is an ordinance against sleeping or cooking on the public sidewalk. Our local officers have been aggressive ticketing and moving these folks along if they appear to be "Camping Out". Call the non-emergency number (503-823-3333) if a problem.

EXCLUSION PROGRAM

A Hollywood Exclusion Program has been suggested by Portland Crime Prevention Coordinator. (see attached sample draft) It would allow those businesses that are part of the program to exclude individuals for certain improper behavior. In turn it would exclude them from other Hollywood participating businesses. Apparently, this program had been used on West Burnside in the past.

The improper behavior would have to be agreed on and many of the details worked out. This is just a proposal so .. If you feel it has merit please let us know.

CREDIT CARD FRAUD IS A CRIME

Take time to Report – Report.

REPORT BY SMART PHONE

There is an app available to report crime. Take a picture of Graffiti and send it to the city so – they can build a case when and if they are caught. You can report Graffiti, Abandon Vehicles, and Potholes – etc. Here is the link http://www.portlandoregon.gov/?c=53613

HOLLYWOOD DISTRICT JOINT EXCLUSION PROGRAM

The following "Rules of Conduct" apply to any individual who enters onto any part of the premises—both inside	
and outside—that is a part of and operated as (business name)	
Any person who violates any of the following rules can be told to leave the property and not return.	

If the excluded person does return to any part of the premises, he or she can be arrested for committing the crime of Criminal Trespass in the Second Degree.

Furthermore, the business manager and employees have the right to refuse service to any person for any non-discriminatory reason.

- 1. No person shall engage in any conduct that violates any Federal, State, or City law.
- 2. No person shall refuse to obey any reasonable request of an employee.
- 3. No person shall use the property in ways that they were not intended to be used.
- 4. No person shall loiter or remain on the business's premises without purchasing a product or service.
- 5. No person shall be allowed to use the business's restroom unless that person has purchased a product.
 - a. No person shall use the business's restroom facilities to bathe, shave, and wash hair or clothes.
- 6. No person shall possess or consume alcoholic beverages, or be in possession of items commonly known to be used to conjunction with illegal drugs.
- 7. No person shall engage in behavior that involves asking for or seeking money from customers or employees of the business.
- 8. No person shall remain at any of the tables, chairs or other fixtures in the business for longer than an expected amount of time, without purchasing additional product or service.
- 9. No person shall interfere with ingress or egress of others at the entrance to the business.
- 10. No person shall possess any firearms, knives or other instruments which could be used to inflict injury upon a person or damage to property.
- 11. No person shall deface, damage, or destroy any merchandise, fixtures or other property of the business.
- 12. No person shall enter the business's premises without proper clothing to include shoes and shirt.
- 13. No person shall bring animals of any type, other than service animals, onto the business's premises unless the animal is a dog or cat in a container.

HOLLYWOOD DISTRICT JOINT EXCLUSION PROGRAM

The premises in the Hollywood District, acting through their representatives, hereby agree to the following:

- 1. Premises will not allow any illegal activity on the property.
- 2. Premises will call the Portland Police Bureau (9-1-1) or the Non-Emergency Line (503-823-3333) when any illegal or nuisance activity is taking place on the property.
- 3. Premises will contact all other premises that are part of the Hollywood District Joint Exclusion Program when an individual violates any of the "Rules of Conduct" identified in Attachment A.
- 4. Premises will issue written notice of exclusions to individuals who are found to be violating any of the "Rules of Conduct" identified in Attachment A.
 - a. The written notice of exclusion will inform an individual that he/she is being excluded from all properties that are part of the Hollywood District Joint Exclusion Program and that the exclusion time period will be for an indefinite period of time; and
 - b. Notify participating businesses of any exclusions issued via an email Listserv.
- 5. Premises will participate in the Portland Police Pureau's Trespass Authorization Program.
- 6. Premises will keep log of problems that occur on the property.
- Premises will not allow any person to loiter or remain on the property without purchasing a product or service.
- 8. Premises will monitor property by conducting daily rounds around the property. These rounds will include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Recognizing and reporting illegal and nuisance activity
 - b. Litter pick-up
 - c. Graffiti documentation and removal
- 9. Premises shall not allow people to remain at any of the tables, chairs or other fixtures inside or outside the property for longer than an expected amount of time, without purchasing additional product.
- 10. Premises will appropriately report and participate in the prosecution of individuals found to be participating in illegal activity on their property.
